What is Voice Box?

Voice Box is a national joke competition for mainstream and special schools, which reminds people that all children need support to build their communication skills and confidence and some need additional specialist help to speak and/or understand what is being said to them.



The competition is run by the Royal College of Speech and Language Therapists (RCSLT) in partnership with the National Association of Head Teachers (NAHT) and is supported by The Communication Trust (TCT).

Schools across England, Scotland and Wales are invited to hold joke competitions in October and November 2017 to find their pupil's funniest joke. Schools will need to submit their winning joke to the RCSLT by **1 December 2017** for a chance to go through to the Grand Final in London. All pupils from the age of five to 19 are eligible to participate.
